The Writing System of the Children of the Forest



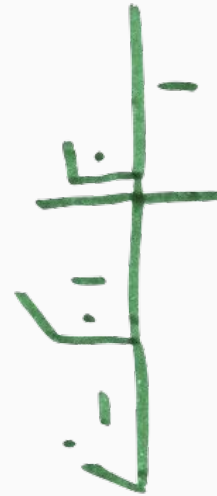
The Children of the Forest:

- Are humanoid
- Are nature-loving
- Used to inhabit all of Westeros
- Wield obsidian weapons into battle
- Have some sort of magic
- Revere weirwoods and ravens as deities



Features of the Script

- No writing surface other than trees
- Written with obsidian shards
- Script is angular
- Written top-to-bottom
- Script is compact and has ligatures
- Reverse abugida



Reverse Abugida

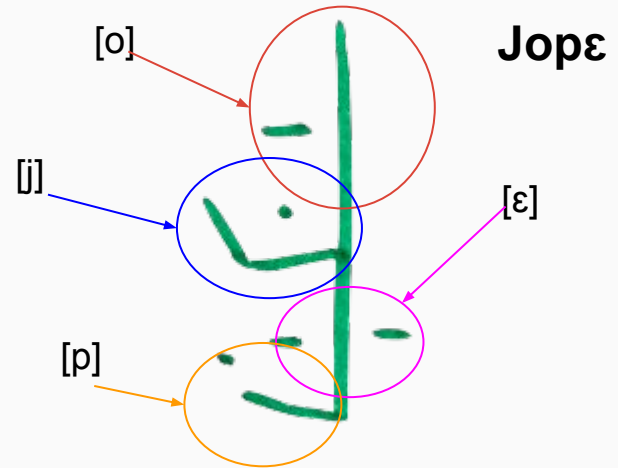
Reverse abugida -- an abugida in which the vowel is the base instead of the consonant. Consonants are not thought of as the base of the word, and are added on as little tails in Arai's system.

How to build syllables

Syllable -- written bottom-to-top,

Word -- written top-to-bottom

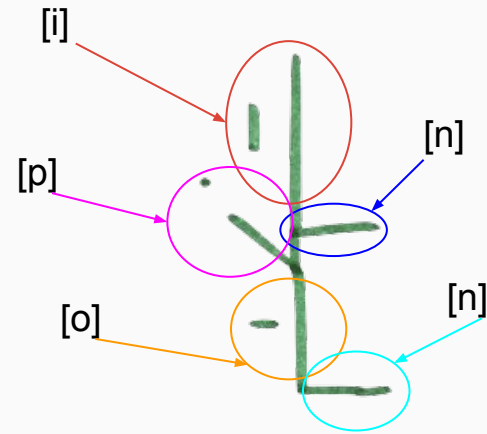
Words change

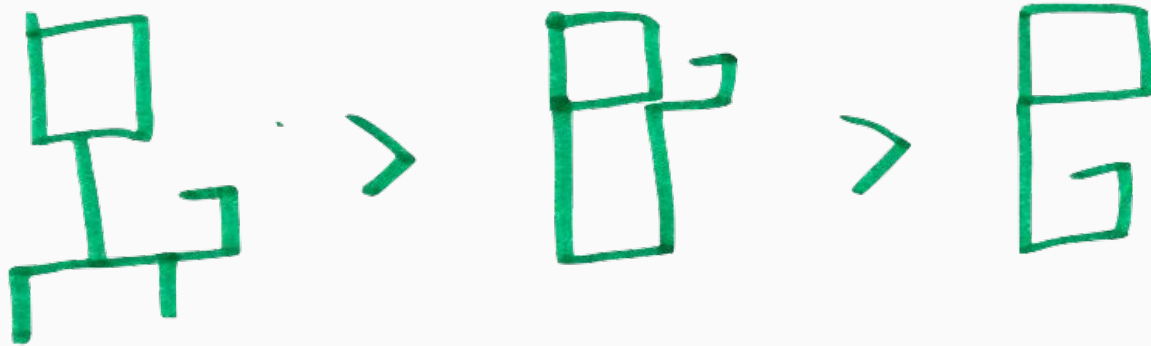

Ligatures

26 different ligatures, standing in for common pronouns, words such as yes/no, fire, water, and snow, and sacred words, such as weirwood.



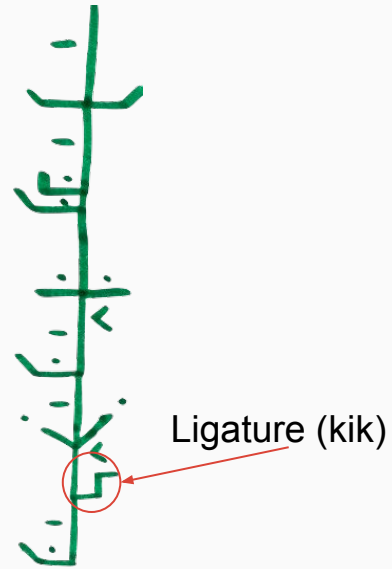
Evolution

Soforaj okoj kikoj?

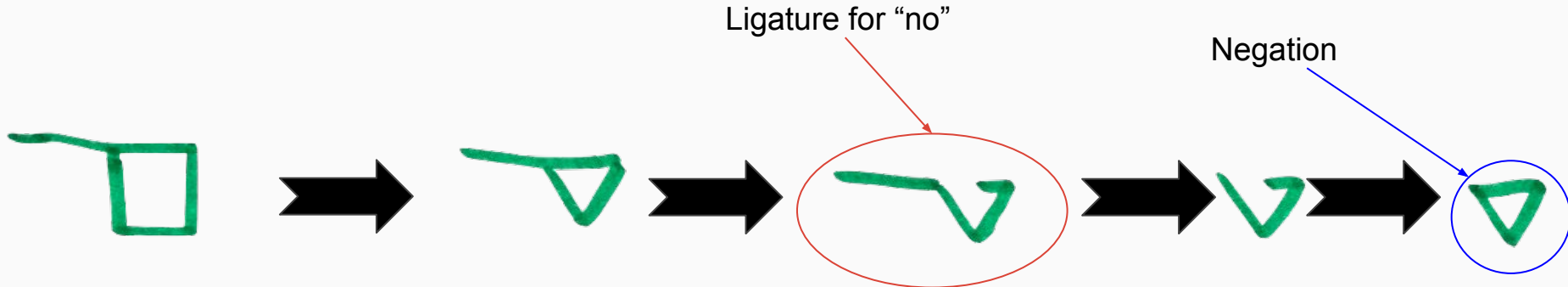
Remember.Q.2SG leg.ACC that.ACC

The determinative pronoun “that” is a ligature



Negation

Negation comes from the ligature for no, which in turn came from a picture of an ax. It can be placed anywhere in a sentence.

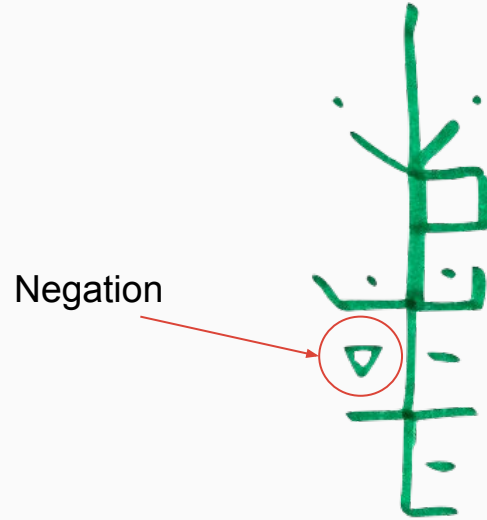


Example of Negation in a Sentence

Written as **Kaug dɛn nuloj**

Read as **Kaʔu dɛ̃ nuloj**

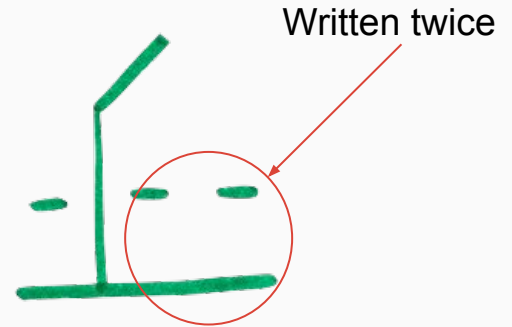
Be.NEG 3SG mouse.ACC



Reduplication

Arai has reduplication as past tense.

The reduplication scheme came from the shortening of the reduplicated syllable and is written sideways or part of the character is written twice.



Lεdε (flew)

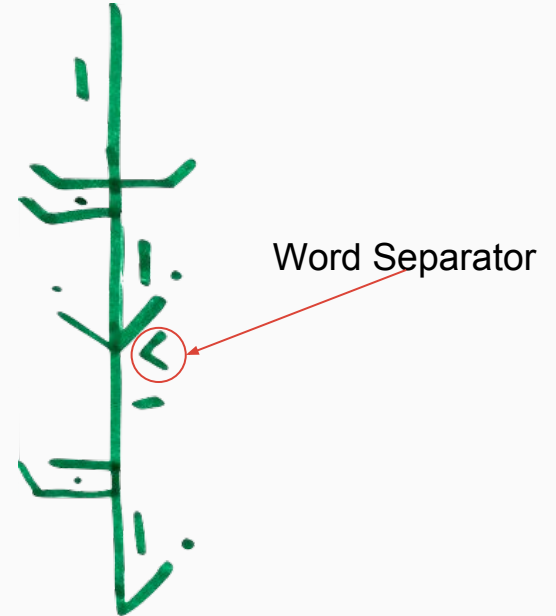
Word Separation

The script tries to conserve space

Written as little sideways caron

Sigej mudej

Cave.GEN green.GEN



How the Script Evolved

- Carved script -- almost no change (historical spelling)
- Exceptions:
 - Ligatures simplified
 - Reduplication merged to base character

Example Text

Samugeʔaj vredoʔ. Poredʒnɛbi,

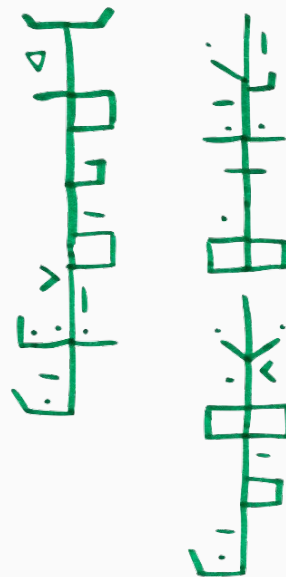
ka dɛbi naʔoj.

[Be alive].HYP(-and).3PL be 3PL good.ACC

I really do not like fish. However,

if they are alive, they are pretty good.
