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Word Order

- ▶ SOV
- ▶ Mod-N
- ▶ Prep-N
- ▶ Rel-N
- ▶ Adv-V

Sentence Examples

- ▶ Intransitive
 - ▶ /setsenən kexēmre betsitkeɪm/
 - ▶ /ABS-I yesterday sleep-PST/
 - ▶ 'I slept yesterday.'
- ▶ Transitive
 - ▶ /misseʊl tʊl settiqXol joʔurkeɪm/
 - ▶ /ERG-You large ABS-sky see-PST/
 - ▶ 'You saw the large sky'

Valency Changing Operations

- ▶ Causative
 - ▶ /mi:ssenēn setsexēm xe:lβetsɪtke:m/
 - ▶ /ERG-I ABS-He CAUS-sleep-PST/
 - ▶ 'I made him sleep.'
- ▶ Anti-Passive
 - ▶ /setseʊl le:ssūmfet na:lʃatberke:m/
 - ▶ /ABS-You DAT-fish ANTI-eat-PST/
 - ▶ "You ate to the fish."

Question Formation

- ▶ Polar Question
 - ▶ /mɪssexəm joʔurkeɪm settaʔɪk ki/
 - ▶ /ERG-He see-PST ABS-cow QPART/
 - ▶ "Did he see the cow?"
- ▶ WH-Question
 - ▶ /mɪsdɛl setsexəm joʔurkeɪm/
 - ▶ /ERG-Who ABS-him see-PST/
 - ▶ 'Who saw him?'

Negation

- ▶ Positive
 - ▶ /mizwwaʊl setsūmfet jatbereɪm/
 - ▶ /ERG.Dual-You ABS-fish eat-PRESENT/
 - ▶ "You two eat fish."
- ▶ Negative
 - ▶ /mizwwaʊl setsūmfet kil jatbereɪm/
 - ▶ /ERG.Dual-You ABS-fish no eat-PRESENT/
 - ▶ "You two don't eat fish."

Relative Clauses

- ▶ /mizwwaʊl xēm tʊl setsexēm feskuːreːm setsūmfet jatbereːm/
- ▶ /Erg.Dual-You that large Abs-It is-Present Abs-fish eat-Present/
- ▶ "You two eat fish that is large."
